## SN 115: Beginning Spanish for Health Care

Beginning Spanish for Health Care is a practical course for non-Spanish speaking health care students. The course will focus on everyday communication with Spanish speakers and will prepare them to develop rapport, manage and control emergency situations, and engage in basic conversations with Spanish speakers.
